PERSONAL WATER CRAFT (PW) – 2009 LAUNCHING CHARGES

The 2009 season will soon be upon us and PW permits are due for payment from 1st March. We write to advise you of the 2009 charges (inc VAT) as follows. **(Please note that there is only one type of PW permit, valid for the year to 1 March 2010)**

<u>Slipway Launching:</u>	£74.34 (Annual - Valid to March 2010) £11.30 (Daily)
<u>PW Permit:</u>	£51.50 (Valid to March 2010)

The permit charge (£51.50) will be waived for members of Hayling Island PW Club who produce approved evidence of membership prior to obtaining their permit. HIPWC information sheets and a membership application form are enclosed with this letter. You will help to reduce congestion at the slipway and avoid launching delays if you obtain your PW Permit early. PW Permits will only be issued at the Harbour Office and you may pay by cash/cheque or debit/credit card (7 days a week from 0900 to 1600).


If you change your PW after obtaining a Permit you must remove the adhesive stickers from the original machine (this can be done with a hot sponge or hair dryer) and return them to the Harbour Office. **We will issue replacement stickers only on presentation to the office of the old stickers.** Replacement of any permit/plaque that is lost/stolen or misplaced will be charged at the appropriate full rate.

INSURANCE

In accordance with national guidelines you are required to hold third party insurance in the amount of at least two million pounds. You may be required to produce evidence of insurance. We hope you have a safe and enjoyable season. Please read your permit carefully before using Langstone Harbour.

Enc. HIPWC Introductory letter, Membership Application Form & Club Events 2009.

The Harbour Master operates a patrol launch within harbour limits for the main purpose of byelaw enforcement. Failure to observe the speed limit or to display a current harbour plaque may lead to prosecution. Your stickers are supplied as evidence that your charges have been paid. These must be prominently displayed on the PW for which it was issued.

THE SPEED LIMIT IN LANGSTONE HARBOUR IS 10 KNOTS
